COR REGISTRATION PROCESS UPDATES

To assist companies in their progress toward achieving Certificate of Recognition (COR[®]) certification and to enhance the integrity of the program, the SCSA has implemented updates to the registration process. **Companies registering for the COR program must achieve certification within 18 months by meeting the following milestones:**

Milestone #1

- Complete minimum training standards and proficiencies required
- Ensure Health and Safety Manual is submitted, reviewed, and approved by the SCSA within 12 months of registration date

Milestone #2

- Schedule and complete a Baseline Audit
- Successfully achieve COR certification within 18 months of the registration date
