## WCB Proposes Drop in Premium Rates

REGINA, SK - The Saskatchewan Workers' Compensation Board (WCB) has proposed a drop in its 2018 average premium rate from \$1.24 in 2017 to \$1.19 in 2018 per hundred dollars of payroll, representing a decrease of four per cent. The announcement was made in Regina at the WCB's annual rate setting consultation with Saskatchewan employers, workers and other stakeholders. [Read More](#)
