Saskatchewan's Injury Rate Declines

Total injury rate drops 5.4% from 2016, however no change in time loss injury rate:

- 2017 total injury rate was 5.25%
- Time loss injury rate remains at 1.86%
- 57% of rate codes have a lower total injury rate than in 2016
- 88% of Saskatchewan employers achieved zero injuries. [Read more.](#)
